COST: The cost is \$9.00 per Scout/Venturer (includes a patch). All Webelos, AOL Scouts, Judges, volunteer judges, and staff will receive a patch.

The purpose of the First Aid Meet is to test patrol skills and the ability of the patrol to respond as a team to emergency situations. Troops and Venturing Crews are encouraged to participate.

In an effort to have more consistency in judging and more realistic scenarios, please read **ALL** of the following information:

VICTIM INFORMATION	Units are asked to have at least one person per patrol to act as a victim for scenarios. This will allow the Scouts to participate in all scenarios. It is strongly suggested that Webelos/AOL Scouts be utilized as victims to encourage future Scouts. Victims will report to registration for assignment and instructions.
PATROL SIZE	Each patrol is to have at least 4 Scouts, but not more than 8 . Patrols may NOT change Scouts once the event has started.
PATROL NAMES & FLAGS	Patrol names must be appropriate to Scouting and can not be changed after registration is completed. Patrol flags should be original design and may be made of various materials. The patrol flag shall be on a pole, but the pole shall be no longer than 6 foot in length. The flag must have the patrol name and unit number on it.
UNIFORMS	Scouts and Scouters are encouraged to wear their Field Uniform Shirts (formerly Class A Uniforms).
TRADING POST	NEW
JUDGING	Scenario judging and test questions will be based on skills covered in the First Aid section of the Scout Handbook and the First Aid Merit Badge. Scouts will also be evaluated on their ability to perform as a team in providing correct first aid to an injured person.

1st AID KIT SUPPLIES

Patrols should have all the first aid supplies listed on the EQUIPMENT LIST. Patrol 1st Aid Kits will be inspected during registration for the required items. Patrol 1st Aid Kits will be scored, with up to 100 points being possible. Any questions or concerns may be directed towards Crew #77 at **VentureCrew77@aol.com** prior to the event registration

PROHIBITED ITEMS

Use of any of these items once the 1st Aid Meet begins at 7pm will disqualify your patrol from that scenario, resulting in a score of o (zero).

Cellphones Tablets Reference Books (Scout Books, etc.)

Stretchers and Commercial Tourniquets are not allowed to be used during the First Aid Meet.

AWARDS

Recognition Awards will be given to the top 3 patrols from Lehigh District with the highest scores. There will be a District Plaque recognizing the yearly winner of each First Aid Meet.

There will be an award given to the winner of the patrol flag competition as chosen by the participating Scouts.

A Recognition Award will be given to the top patrol from outside of Lehigh District with the highest score.

JUDGES NEEDED

Each Unit must provide at least 1 judge for each patrol for the 1st Aid Meet. If we do not have enough judges, those patrols that did not provide a judge, will not be permitted to participate.

Judges should have 1st Aid experience (Merit Badge Counselors; First Aid Instructors) or certification (Standard 1st Aid, Emergency Response; Emergency Medical Responder, EMT, Paramedic; etc.). Please encourage trained individuals to assist with this event.

Judges should register with their unit or they may contact the event chairperson.

VOLUNTEERS

Volunteers are needed to:

- Act as victims (Leaders/Parents/Webelos/AOL Scouts)
- Judge
- Assist with tabulating scores

2025 Lehigh District 1st Aid Meet ITEMS FOR PATROL 1st AID KITS



NEW FOR 2025!!! MUST READ!!!

The below listed item should be in your Patrol First Aid Kit for the 2025 Lehigh District 1st Aid Meet. Each Patrol First Aid Kit will be inspected by judges prior to entry into the 1st Aid Meet. The Patrol First Aid Kit will be scored by the judges, up to 100 points will be awarded. If you have any questions concerning your first aid kit, please contact Venturing Crew #77 at venturecrew77@aol.com.

MINIMUM ITEMS

- -1 Empty plastic water bottle
- -2 Simulated cold packs (can be a used one; should not be cold)
- -1 Sheet or blanket (to place on floor)
- -1 Sheet or blanket (for patient use)
- -2 Roller bandages (gauze roll or Coban)
- -5 Triangular Bandages, Neckerchiefs, or strips of cloth
- -1 Roll of adhesive tape
- -1 Elastic Bandage (ACE Bandage) or Coban
- -5 Gauze Pads (3"x3" or 4"x4"; can use Gauze Sponges)
- -1 Simulated Triple Antibiotic Ointment (tube or container must be marked with "TAO" if simulating package)
- -1 Bar of Soap or liquid soap (can be simulated)
- -1 Pair of Scissors
- -Pencil, pen, and paper
- -2 Rigid Splints (should be about 30-36" long (a lower leg splint); can be made out of cardboard (double-thick), rolled newspaper; wood; or commercially made)
- -1 Dowel (wood, plastic, metal, about 1/4" thick and about 6-8" long)

ITEMS NOT PERMITTED: Commercial tourniquet, stretchers
