CAMPERSHIP PROGRAM & POLICY

General Information

Funds are available to assist Bucktail Council youth with financial need to experience Summer Resident Camp at Camp Mountain Run. They are not intended to provide the entire fee for Summer Camp.

Requests for camperships must meet the following guidelines:

- Must be made using the attached campership form and be turned into the Bucktail Council Service Center (89 Nolan Rd., Penfield, PA 15849) no later than March 15, 2025. Campership applications received after this date will not be considered. The entire form must be completed in full or it will not be considered.
- 2. Camperships awarded will be granted for a percentage less than half of the early bird fee.
- 3. Each applicant is reviewed individually and must stand on the applicant's own merit. Completion of the campership form does not guarantee that a campership grant will be awarded. There are no quotas assigned to units. Scouts from units which conduct a Friends of Scouting campaign and participate in Council Product Sales will receive first preference.
- 4. Camperships are issued to Scouts currently registered in the Bucktail Council attending a long-term camp sponsored by Bucktail Council. They are not granted to those Scouts camping out of council.

All youth using council facilities, whether for short-term overnight or long-term summer camp periods, are already subsidized in part by the council's yearly operating budget, which pays for taxes, a year-round camp ranger, maintenance, liability insurance, heat, lights, etc. The local community (though United Way allocations, Friends of Scouting, popcorn sales, trust fund income and Campership donations) pays this cost.

Unit leaders will be notified in writing of approved camperships and the amount of the grant by April 15, 2025. **Camperships that are awarded are not transferable.**

Paying a Scout's way to camp is a joint effort of the unit (Troop, Pack, or Crew), the Scout and their family, and the campership program. One form must be filled out for each Scout in the family.
