BALOO Information

- 1. Prior to coming to camp for the weekend BALOO course, you must take the online prerequisite course. You can find instructions for taking the online course at the bottom of this page.
- 2. Arrive in camp by 7:00 PM on Friday for check-in. Light working supper will be available. Course begins with opening ceremony at 7:30 PM, followed by classes.
- 3. The course is held at Camp Hart at the Musser Scout Reservation. Use the address 1425 Camp Road, Pennsburg, PA for GPS directions (Lat: 40.3647, Lon: -75.4270).
- 4. Park in the Camp Hart parking lot at the intersection of Camp Road and Miller Road (across Camp Road from the Dining Hall).
- 5. Leave your gear in your car. You will be advised when to take it to your campsite.
- 6. Check in inside the Hart Dining Hall across Camp Road from the parking lot.
- 7. Dress for the weather, most of the course will be outdoors. Consider bringing extra footwear (should your primary ones get wet). You may leave extra clothing and outer wear in your vehicles. Check the weather and bring rain gear, if indicated, as this course runs rain, snow, or shine. **There are pavilions in each patrol site and other areas to get out of the wind and wet weather, if we get that.**
- 8. This is a Class " A " uniformed event. If you do not currently own a uniform, you DO NOT need to buy one for this course.
- 9. Personal equipment needed: Tent, ground pad, ground cloth, sleeping bag (suggest blanket insert for inside bag), small day pack for the day's traveling around, water bottle (filled), reusable hot/cold cup, reusable spoon and bowl, pocketknife, folding camp chair.
- 10. Sleeping options on Friday night: While everyone will pitch a tent for this course, you have the option of sleeping in the tent, sleeping in a lean-to (electric for CPAP available on request), or sleeping in a hammock, etc. The course syllabus does not require you to sleep in a tent or sleep on the ground. However, if you choose that, come prepared.
- 11. All food will be provided for all participants. It will be cooked for you or you will be provided with the food and equipment to cook when required. **If you have a dietary restriction of any kind, please let us know as soon as possible to review your needs.**
- 12. An email will be sent to you with any additional information or course changes shortly before the start of the course.
