Required Paperwork to Bring

Youth

All youth participating **ARE REQUIRED** to bring an up-to-date Part A/B medical form.

Adults

All adults participating will need an up-to-date Part A/B medical form. If an adult is NOT registered with the BSA, but is volunteering, they must bring a copy of their current YPT and as well as copies of the PA required clearances.

Preparation and Prerequisites

- Scouts are encouraged to obtain and read the current merit badge book or use [All Merit Badges A-Z | Boy Scouts of America \(scouting.org\)](#).
- Scouts may print the corresponding worksheets to use as a tool to organize notes and document their work. [Merit Badge Worksheets \(usscouts.org\)](#)
- To earn the merit badge(s), Scouts need to complete all prerequisites and show proof of completion. Prerequisites and proof required will be listed in the class schedule and sign up.
 - If Scouts **DO NOT** have the prerequisites complete, there is a chance they may not be able to attend the class. This is left up to the Counselors discretion, because it may affect the rest of the classes performance and make the class go overtime.
- Scouts should bring the following items to the Merit Badge University:
 - Any merit badge worksheets, prerequisites work and proof.
 - Pen/pencil(s) and spare paper.

- A packed lunch and refillable water bottle with their names and troop numbers on them.
- Up-to-date health forms.
- Scouts must be prepared to discuss and demonstrate all requirements.
- Scouts are encouraged to wear their official BSA uniform along with appropriate footwear.

Cancelation/Class Change Policy

All Merit Badge Day registrations are final. There are NO refunds for cancellations. If a Scout can no longer attend, he/she will forfeit their registration fee. There will be NO credits for future events and NO registration transfers to other Scouts. There are also NO class changes once you register. Scoutbook

All Scouts **MUST** be linked to the Merit Badge Counselor they are working with, and the Scoutmaster (or Assistant Scoutmaster) **MUST** sign off.

- Scoutbook is a digital blue card and must be used the same way.
- In the Guide to Advancement, 7.0.0.3, Scouts **MUST** meet with the Unit Leader (Scoutmaster or Assistant Scoutmaster ONLY – Page 2).
- The Scoutmaster **MUST** sign off on the merit badge, just like they would a physical blue card.

○ If there is ***NO*** signature, the Scout cannot work with the Counselor.

- If the Scout is **NOT** link with the Counselor, they cannot get the credit for any requirements they completed during their sessions.
- Counselor membership ID numbers and email addresses are listed for each merit badge to allow you to connect your Scout to them in Scoutbook.

Scouts may also opt to garden over the Spring and Summer of 2026 and reach out to Mr. Valent after tending the garden for 90 days.
