Arrival & Check-In

For Full Weekend Participants:

- You may arrive to get into your assigned Potomac Home anytime after 6:00 p.m on Friday evening.
- Please send **one (1)** person from your Pack down to Pathfinder Lodge between **7:00 p.m. - 9:00 p.m.** to check your group in with our staff once your whole group has arrived. ***If you arrive after 9:00 p.m., please check in during breakfast on Saturday morning.***
 - Full weekend adults **MUST** have PA Clearances/Non-PA Resident Disclosure in order to stay overnight.
 - All participants **MUST** have their medical form parts A & B
- To Check-Out on Sunday morning, please send **one (1)** person from your Pack to pick up your packets that will include your medicals, clearances, patches, and other materials

For Saturday Only Day Pass Participants:

- Please arrive to Check-In at Pathfinder Lodge between **8:00 a.m. and 8:50 a.m.**
 - All participants must have their medical form parts A & B.
 - Day adults are not required to bring PA Clearances but a current copy of Safeguarding Youth Certification is encourage.
- Day participants will Check-Out at Pathfinder Lodge after program ends at 4:00 p.m.

What to Bring

(Your Cold Weather Checklist)

Every Scout Should Have:

- Warm winter coat
- Snow pants or waterproof outer layer
- Hat that covers the ears
- Gloves or mittens (extra pairs are encouraged)
- Warm socks (extra pairs are encouraged)
- Waterproof boots with good traction
- Water bottle
- Hand warmers
- Sunscreen / sunglasses
- Small backpack/day pack



Dress in Layers!

- Base layer: moisture-wicking shirt (not cotton!)
- Middle layer: fleece or sweatshirt
- Outer layer: waterproof, wind-resistant winter coat

Warm and dry Scouts have the best day!

Health & Safety

- First aid is available onsite during the event
- Activities may be adjusted based on weather/temperatures
- Staff will provide instructions via the TeamReach app with real-time updates.
