REGISTRATION & COST

Registration can be found online through the Council Calendar which links directly to the Black Pug event or scan the QR code below which takes you directly to the Black Pug event page.

The early bird registration is \$12 for Youth & \$3 for adults which ends on March 24th at 11:59 PM.

Regular registration will start March 25th and is \$15 for Youth & \$5 for adults.

Online registration closes April 11th.

Day-Of Registration is \$20 for Youth & \$10 for adults. All early & regular registered members are guaranteed a patch (design on cover page), day-of registrants only as supplies last.



DAY-OF CHECK-IN

Check-in starts at 6:00 PM Friday April 25th at the pavilion located at the back of the parking lot located on the left side of the park (with Main Street to your back).

TENTING & AMENITIES

Assigned tenting spaces will be assigned based on the size of your group.

Each Troop will be responsible for supplying its own tents, food, cooking supplies.

There is a public restroom where water would be available if not brought along or needs a refill.

Please note that the park does not allow campfires, all cooking will need to be done on propane stoves or raised platforms to avoid burning the grass.

MEETINGS

SPL and leaders meeting to be held Friday night at 9:00 PM at the chek-in pavilion to review activities on Saturday which will start at 9:00 AM.

SATURDAY ACTIVITY STATIONS

Several stations of activities will be set up for the Scouts to participate in through a shotgun style start and rotate through in order. Pending on their ability to solve/complete the station, Frontier wooden nickels will be awarded. Please have a secure bag to collect these in as you will be able to use during an auction of various donated items from local companies and individuals.

We will have a lunch break from roughly 11:30 AM to 1:30 PM. If you start at a station close to or at 11:30 AM we ask that you please finish that station prior to going to lunch so you may proceed to the next station upon returning from lunch. This will help with the flow from station to station and prevent backups and lines.

Upon competition of all stations, you may return to your campsite and prepare for your evening meal.

COOKING COMPETITION

Saturday's evening meal will be judged with additional wooden nickels awarded at approximately 5:30 PM.
