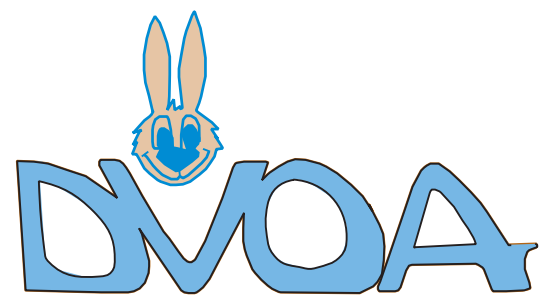


HAWK MOUNTAIN
