Camping Details

- **Cabins** - First come first serve. Please make sure you leave your cabin as clean as you found it. Please do your best to separate genders; mixed gender families may stay together.
- **Tents** - First come first serve basis either (a) near the cabins, (b) in the field near the pool and ranger post building.

Campfires: Permitted only in fire rings which are located in various locations throughout the camp. You may bring your own fire ring as well. Group campfire on Saturday night; all Packs and Scouts are encouraged to perform skits or songs.
