This year’s sleds will serve mainly to carry the team’s day packs so they don’t need to be worn.

- SLED TEAMS shall be a minimum of 5 and a max. of 10 scouts – NO EXCEPTIONS. Units may combine.
- TEAMS must have a sled to compete. Wheels are forbidden. Sled may be carried.
- Mayor’s word is final on scoring or deductions
- VISITS will be 25 minutes. Travel allowance is 5 minutes
- AOLs may NOT use .22 rifles, shotguns, or steel tomahawks. Alternative activities compliant with the GTSS are in place for AOLs, and they WILL fully participate in all other challenges.
- PLACING THE WINNERS – Each Mayors will rank sleds 1 through 24 for performance at that town. Snow-blind Assayers will then tabulate the results and place the winners.
- Any sticks or staffs are to be used only for their intended purposes. Scouts caught using them inappropriately or committing other dangerous acts will cause their sled team to get a mark on their map. Second incident, another mark is placed on the map. Three strikes and they are OUT OF THE KLONDIKE! NOTE THAT NO STAVES ARE REQUIRED ON THE SLED THIS YEAR!
- During the Highland-type events, cheering and yelling your support and general silliness will NOT be discouraged 😊 ...even a little
