

Directions to norse:

From Boston, MA

Take I-93 South to MA-3 South. Merge onto US-44 West via Exit 7B toward Plymouth. Merge onto MA-3 South via the exit on the left toward Cape Cod. Take the MA-3A exit, Exit 10, toward Kingston/Plymouth. Turn right onto MA-3A/Main St. Continue to follow MA-3A. Turn left onto MA-27/National Pl. Turn right onto MA-106/Plymouth St. Camp Norse will be on your left.

From Providence, RI

Take I-95 North toward Boston. Merge onto MA-24 North via Exit 8A toward Brockton. Merge onto MA-44 East via Exit 13A toward Middleboro. Turn right onto MA-58 South. Turn left onto MA-106 East. Camp Norse will be on your right.

Electricity can be made available for sites if cpap machines are needed. Please let us know of any necessary accessibility accommodations prior to arrival to turtle trek. Restrooms will be within safe walking distance of all sites. Single stall shower facilities are available in several locations throughout the camp.
