



PATROL EQUIPMENT (Must be on your sled throughout the course)

- Klondike sled
- Compass
- Patrol flag
- 10 pieces of 10ft lengths of rope for lashing
- 6 poles of 6ft lengths
- Matches
- First aid kit, triangular bandages
- One blanket or tarp
- Scout handbook
- Clipboard, pencil and paper
- Drinking water to stay hydrated
- One 4 man tent

Additional equipment needed

Scout: pocket knife, drinking cup, adequate layers of clothing, adequate footwear, hat and gloves.

Troop: firewood may be necessary. All meals will be provided by Troops
