



Adult Pinewood Derby

Classic Circuit Rules

1. Car must be made from an official Pinewood Derby kit.
2. Width shall not exceed 2-3/4 inches.
3. Length shall not exceed 7 inches.
4. Weight shall not exceed 5 ounces.
5. Height shall not exceed 3 inches.
6. Axles, wheels, and body shall be from the materials provided in the official kit.
7. Wheel bearings, washers, and bushings are prohibited.
8. No lubricating oil may be used. Axles may be lubricated with powdered graphite or silicone.
9. The car shall not ride on any kind of spring.
10. The car must be free-wheeling, with no starting devices.
11. No loose materials of any kind are allowed in the car.
12. The forward most edge of the car must be 3/4" wide to rest against the starting gate.

13. Cars must have no more or no less than 4 wheels.
14. Only dry powder lubricants are permitted and all types of liquid lubricants including all greases and oils are prohibited.
15. All lubrication or other service must be completed prior to presenting the car for technical inspection. Once a car passes inspections, no modification are allowed. The car will be held in the pit area during the race.
16. Cars must be capable of accepting and retaining its assigned car numbered decal.
17. Each car must pass inspection before it will be allowed to race. The scale used on race day is the only official scale. If a car does not pass inspection, the owner will be informed of the reason for failure, and will be given time within the official check in time period to make any adjustments. If the car is not able to meet specifications, it will be disqualified.
