

Welcome to Camp Norse 2026

Dear Families,

We are excited about all the adventures that your camper will experience during their week of day camp! All campers will receive their den assignments and camp t-shirt when checked in on Mondays. **Please wear this t-shirt throughout the week.** There are a few items to highlight:

CAMP PROGRAM HOURS: Monday through Friday, 9AM-4PM; **RAIN OR SHINE**

DRIVING IN CAMP

DO NOT exceed **10 MPH** in camp and be mindful of campers walking in camp.

CHECK-IN AT THE WELCOME CENTER

- Daily Check-In starts at 8:30 AM (unless you are extended care, see below)
- Campers check in by **8:50 AM** so the camp program can start PROMPTLY at **9AM**

MONDAY CHECK-IN:

- Park your car and walk your camper to the check-in tables in front of the Welcome Center.
- *Monday check-in takes a little longer than Tuesday-Friday* so plan accordingly.
- If all your camper's registration paperwork is completed as well as their Health Form your check-in will run smoothly.

TUESDAY - FRIDAY CHECK-IN

- Do not get out of your car, please follow the curve of the parking lot and drop off your camper following the other cars. *Note: there will be someone directing cars.*

AFTERNOON PICK-UP

- Monday-Friday campers will be **dismissed starting at 4PM from the Welcome Center**
- Please arrive after **3:50 PM- 4PM**. We will not be ready before then. The parking lot attendant will check your ID and place you in the line of cars. We will bring your camper to your vehicle. DO NOT get out.
- Campers will be sent home with ONLY AUTHORIZED persons on their list, any changes to your camper's list needs to be sent to the Camp Director
- **Photo ID is required to pick up ANY camper.** NO camper will be dismissed without proper identification. This is for ALL our campers' safety.
- *IF you need to dismiss your camper before 4PM, contact the Camp Director. Due to distances in the camp, we need advanced notice.* No dismissals after 3:15PM.

FRIDAY AFTERNOONS

- Join us for the **Magee Family Campfire Extravaganza!**
- Campers will perform skits, songs, and talents that they have been working on during the week.
- The **event is from 3PM to 4PM** and is an opportunity for the campers' adults to see them shine!
- *Please arrive between 2:15 PM-2:45 PM* so we can check you in and escort you to your seat.

EXTENDED CARE

- Available for campers who register for this option for an additional cost.
- Morning extended care starts at 8AM - Monday through Friday
- Afternoon extended care pick up between 4PM-6PM Monday through Thursday
- **NO AFTERNOON Extended Care on FRIDAYS -pick up by 4PM**

WHAT TO BRING

- Camp uniform is **shorts, camp shirt, hat and sneakers/hiking boots**
- NO open-toed footwear is allowed at camp
- Camp all outside so dress according to the weather
- Campers are encouraged to wear their swimsuit to camp so they only change once
- Backpack with change of clothes, swimsuit and towel
- Rain gear or jacket
- Sunscreen and bug repellent that your camper can apply themselves
- LABEL anything your camper brings (we do have a lost and found outside the office)

****Valuables, umbrellas, toys, knives, and electronic devices such as phones are NOT PERMITTED at Camp. Campers are responsible for each item they bring to camp, Camp Norse is not responsible for any misplaced or broken items.****

LUNCH

- **Bagged lunch and reusable water bottle** are daily requirements
- Water stations are available to refill and campers are encouraged to stay hydrated
- Campers are expected to carry their backpacks, including their lunch with them through the day.
Refrigeration is NOT available
- Due to allergies of campers and staff, we offer nut free tables at lunch
- **Staff and campers are NOT allowed to share lunches**

MEDICATIONS/HEALTH NEEDS

- All medications should be given to the Health Officer at check-in, they should be in their original packaging and contain a label with the camper's name
- Campers with emergency medications such as inhalers and epi-pens need to speak to the Health Officer at Monday check-in
- **All persons coming to camp whether youth or adult need to have a health form on file with our Health Officer**

TRADING POST

- Our trading post offers snacks, drinks, Day Camp gear, and small gifts
- You can send in money with your camper to enjoy the trading post but we are not responsible for lost money. It is recommended that campers place their money in a safe place with their name on it in their backpack.
- Adults may use credit or debit cards for anything over \$5, but please DO NOT send your camper with your credit card!
