Camp Location

This year, our prehistoric adventure will take place on the spacious grounds of St. Theresa's Catholic Church, located at 11001 Dorchester Rd., Summerville, SC 29485. The church campus provides plenty of room for Scouts to explore, discover, and enjoy all the exciting camp activities, transforming the space into our very own dino dig site!

Drop-off & Pick-up Times

- Monday–Thursday: Drop-off at 7:45 AM, Pick-up at 4:00 PM
- Friday: Drop-off at 7:45 AM, Pick-up immediately following the Closing Campfire (TBD)

Registration & Fees

- Early Registration: \$135 (Deadline: March 1, 2026)
- Regular Registration-Shirt Guaranteed: \$150 (March 2 – May 15, 2026)
- Late Registration-Shirt ***NOT*** Guaranteed: \$160 (After May 15, 2026, if space allows)
- No Registrations allowed after June 1, 2026

Note: Registration includes all program activities/supplies, a camp T-shirt, patch, and bag. Scouts bring their own lunch and refillable water bottle daily.

How to Register

1. Complete the Online Registration Form
 - Visit www.mycampmanager.com to complete the registration online -OR-

- Visit the council office to complete the registration in person.

We suggest the unit register all scouts together to avoid duplicate registrations due to parents signing their scout up individually.

Please register the scout as the rank they will be as of June 1, 2026 to ensure they are placed in the correct dens.

2. Submit Required Forms (*Due 1st Day of Camp*)
 - BSA Annual Health & Medical Record (Parts A & B only)
 1. Notify the Camp and Program Director of any allergies or special accommodations needed so we can plan the program accordingly.
 - Copy of current insurance card
 - Bug Spray and Sunscreen Permission Slip
3. Make Payment

Payment is due at the time of registration to secure your spot. This can be paid online when registering on the website or in person at the council office.

What to Bring Each Day

To make the most of their adventure, every Scout should come prepared each day of camp. Be sure your Scout arrives with a refillable water bottle, their official camp T-shirt, and name tag for easy identification. Their camp bag which is needed to carry belongings, along with a packed lunch to keep their energy up for all the activities. Scouts may also bring a small amount of petty cash for the Trading Post, where they can pick up snacks or fun camp souvenirs. Please try to bring food items that do not contain nuts of any kind to help cut down on accidental exposures.
