What to Expect

The founder of the Scouting movement, Lord Robert Baden-Powell, described Scouting as a game with a purpose. Wood Badge is the best, most effective game you will ever play as a Scout leader. The course is a two-step process, consisting of a practical phase followed by an application phase.

The practical portion (the 6-day course) will take place both in the classroom and in the outdoors. Scouters are given the chance to live in a Scouting atmosphere for an extended period of time. This experience will provide a deeper understanding of Scouting and the impact it can have on the youth in your unit and in your community.

The application phase will take place after the course is complete. Participants will write a contract with themselves during the course, outlining how they will apply the lessons learned during the course. This contract is called a "Ticket". The Ticket is written prior to the end of the course and is the method you will use to bring your experience home to your Scouting world. Participants will have up to 18 months to complete their Ticket. Once complete, the Wood Badge award is presented.

Wood Badge has been developed for ALL Cub Scout, Boy Scout, Varsity Scout and Venturing leaders, as well as council and district leaders. Who should attend? YOU should attend!
