REQUIRED PERSONAL GEAR

- Class A Scout Shirt
- Scout pants/shorts
- Class B shirts (plain t-shirts – no logos, etc. are also acceptable)
- Scout belt
- Scout socks (will accept solid white socks or grey wool socks without visible logos)
- Backpacking pack* (a trunk or gear box is NOT ideal)
- 2-man tent with ground cloth/tarp* (4, 6, 8 man tents will not fit in the campsite)
- Personal First Aid Kit*
- (2) big water bottles*

- Paper & pencil (pen)
- Pocket knife (no bigger than palm)
- Shower shoes (in shower only)
- Extra glasses/contacts (if needed)
- Disposable Camera

CONTRABAND - NOT ALLOWED - ZERO TOLERANCE

- Cell phones/ electronics/ communication devices
- Matches, lighters, fire starters
- FOOD (snacks, candy etc.) of any kind
- DRINKS (additives, powders, energy, caffeine, etc.) of any kind
- Tobacco products
- Aerosol cans
- Stoves/lanterns
- Books (except scout and religious)
- Anything illegal
- Bathing Suits
- Playing Cards/Games
- Non-Scout Related Class B's (solid color t-shirts without logos/graphics are allowed)
- Knives bigger than palm, non-folding knives, extra knives, axes, saws
- Tools
- Non-Scout Related Hats/Apparel
- Money/Wallet
- Open-toe shoes (unless shower shoes)
- Hammocks

Any items that are brought to the course will be sent home with parents or will be confiscated during the course until the closing ceremony where the parent will have to pick up the items.
