What to Bring

The following list is suggested by certainly is not all encompassing. Please double check your gear before arriving at camp.

- Class A Uniform for Opening ceremony, evening meals, campfires and flag lowering.
- Clothes (shorts, light weight pants, pack t-shirts, pajamas or sleeping clothes, underwear, and socks) enough for at least 3 days + extras
- Extra socks
- Jacket, sweater, or sweatshirt
- Clothes that can get wet
- Towel, shoes for shower area only (**NOT TO BE WORN ANYWHERE ELSE**)
- Athletic shoes or comfortable hiking boots and 1 pair of shoes that can get wet (**NO CROCS**)
- Plastic bag for wet clothing and towels for the ride home
- Poncho or raincoat
- Backpack or duffle bag that can be easily carried to campsite
- Tent
- Sleeping bag or blankets and sheets and a small pillow
- Toiletry kit (toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, comb, etc)
- Re-usable water bottle
- Webelos and AOLs are permitted to bring (**ONE**) pocket knife, but they must have completed their Whittling Chip and have it on their person at all times
- Sunscreen and non-aerosol insect repellent
- Flashlight, watch
- Bicycle and Helmet
- Appropriate swimwear for water activities.

- Electronic games or radios

- Guns or archery items
- Alcohol and Illegal Drugs
- Candles, Fireworks
- ATVs, RVs
- Pets
- Expensive Cameras or valuables of any kind
