activities. Training will be conducted following the BSA guidelines of "Climb On Safely", "Belay On", National Camp Accreditation Program (NCAP) Standards,

and IWC's Climbing/Rappelling Policies and Procedures.

This Level I course is intended for BSA registered adults who meet the above prerequisites and are interested in learning and teaching the basics of climbing and rappelling on IWC's Climbing Towers. Upon successful completion of the course (to include demonstrating climbing/rappelling core competencies), adults will receive their BSA "Artificial Climbing Structure Instructor Level I" training card.

BSA registered youth who meet the above prerequisites are also eligible to take the Level I course. Upon successful completion (to include demonstrating climbing/rappelling core competencies), youth will receive their BSA "Instructor in Training" card.

Your training card for Level 1 is valid for 1 year upon successful completion of the course. We hope that you will become an active instructor!
