- Check out with staff
- Leave no trace

Food will not be provided so plan accordingly.

ALLERGY ALERT: there are 2 honey bee hives located on the farm.

Please bring a fishing pole, tackle, and bait for the fishing during free time.

**NOTE: if you are interested in helping to lead an activity, please see staff at check in.**

There will be firewood for sale onsite if you need it for a very reasonable cost. ABOVE GROUND FIRE RINGS MUST BE USED.

Be respectful of the farm as it is still a work in progress as the owner is working continuously to make the area better to suit the Scouting program.

Join us Saturday evening at the campfire for fun with Skits & Songs! Leaders please have your ideas submitted by the end of lunch on Saturday.

Certain spots on the farm may be muddy so please pack extra shoes & clothes you don't mind getting dirty.

Bring tents, sleeping bag/ blankets, camping gear. Please check the weather and pack accordingly..

You may drive to campsites to unload, then all cars must be moved from campsite areas and parked in the field field. Please remember to place your information car tag in the windshield. Your unit trailer may remain at campsite if space is available.

Access to potable water is available, but it is located a significant distance from the campsites. You are encouraged to bring more water than you think you will need or a way to transport it over the distance.

A current BSA Health Form is required for EVERY participant. Your health forms should be presented at the time of your arrival. If you plan to attend with a unit that keeps a binder, the binder should be delivered with the first on-site campers. This is at the request of our Health Officer. Please adhere to this request.

No pets. No alcohol. Smoking in designated areas only.
