We are excited for the upcoming Council Camporee in Camden Oct 17-19, 2025. Below you will find some questions and answers, the schedule, and a couple of maps. Should you need anything during the event April Mayfield can be reached at 803.626.6651 via call or text.

Ouestions

Are fires permitted? Only in above the ground fire pits. NO fires or cooking is permitted on the ground.

What do we do with our trash? There will be roll carts from the City of Camden placed around the site. If these are full, please pack out your trash.

Where do I park the Troop trailer? Girl Troop trailers are permitted in the purple oval on the map near the Girl Troop camping area. Boy Troop trailers are allowed to be parked in a designated area that will be near their campsites. This will be near the Kershaw House you will be directed to the correct area. Kitchens should be located near their trailers. Trailers are permitted to be dropped in designated areas, and the vehicle will need to park in the designated parking area.

How do I drop off the Troop trailer? There is an entrance just for the vehicle pulling the trailer on Bull St. This is a gated entrance that will be locked at 9pm. Be sure to pull the trailer into the designated trailer parking area, drop the trailer, then move the vehicle to the designated parking area.

Where do we cook? You may cook near your trailer as long as there are no fires or coals on the ground.

Where are the restrooms? There will be 6 porta potties and a mobile restroom trailer.

Is there water available? Yes, there are multiple buildings with water spigots. This is potable water. Might want wagon or multiple Scouts to carry water.

Can I park where it says no parking on the map? No, these areas are subject to towing because they are not Historic Camden property, or we have events happening there. Please only park in the designated parking lots.

Are there assigned campsites? No, pick an area for your Troop. Boys are in the Orange oval on the map and Girls are in the Purple oval. Please be mindful of your space and other troops around you. Please be mindful also of the property. DO NOT camp in the taller grass. DO NOT camp in the fort.

Can we climb on the berms? No, this is a safety risk. DO NOT climb on any berms or into any ditches or ditch like areas.

Where is check-in? At the Tavern. On one of the maps marked as First-aid & HQ. Could be outside or inside.

The map says Pond, are rods and bait supplied? No, if you would like to fish, please bring your own poles and bait. The pond is stocked with catfish.

What does the Orange line on the map actually mean? There is a significant ditch there. Everyone must use a flashlight at night, NO EXCEPTIONS.

Will there be a campfire Saturday night? No. There will be a show with skits and songs. Per City of Camden ordinance, we are not allowed to have a large fire. Will it still be fun, absolutely!

What do we need to pack? What you would typically pack for a campout in tents.

Do we need bug spray and sunscreen? Yes, you will most likely need and want these.

Will the lights on the Kershaw House be on at night? No, I asked for the light to be off to help better with being able to sleep. This means that once it gets dark it is very dark. You must use a flashlight at night.

Can I look around at what's on the property? Yes, there are historical markers all over with a lot to see. Some of the staff will be on property with us and many of their volunteers will be present also. Please be mindful of safety. Do not climb on any berms or in the ditches or mote looking places. Safety should be a concern when looking around. Also, DO NOT destroy or damage any items on property.

What will the weather be like for the weekend? According to The Weather Channel App it says sunny with a high of 79 and low of 49. Of course, this is always subject to change so just remember to be prepared.

Do I need to use the buddy system? Yes, we are Scouts!


