Course goal

To provide all Scout leaders, both new and veteran, with ideas and methods for developing an effective Scouting program utilizing youth leadership, advancement, and outdoor skills.

Scoutmaster Position - Specific Training

Basic information and tools for Scoutmasters/Assistant Scoutmasters in the use of the Patrol Method, the Aims and Methods of Scouting, the roles of adult leaders, developing youth leadership, and the responsibilities of the Troop Committee. Scoutmasters and Assistant Scoutmasters who complete this course, *Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills*, and *Youth Protection Training* are considered “trained” for those positions.

Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills (IOLS)

Working as patrols, this hands-on course introduces adult leaders to the practical outdoor skills they need to lead Scouts in the out-of-doors. Along with *Scoutmaster Position-Specific* this course is required of all direct contact leaders registered in Boy Scout Troops in order to be considered “trained”.

Prerequisite: ALL participants are required to have completed the latest version of *Youth Protection Training* before attending this training course.

Youth Protection Training (YPT): This online course replaces all previous *Youth Protection* training and is required training for ALL adults to complete. Adult volunteers must complete their training by **October 1, 2018**. If an adult volunteer fails to obtain this updated training by October, they will no longer be allowed to participate in Scouting activities until the course is completed.
