

# DETAILS

## Event fees:

Registration is \$15 per person. **Except: Siblings 4 and under are free.**

## Meals:

The Dining Hall will be open, and meals may be purchased ahead for an additional fee of \$20 per person. You will get 2 breakfasts, 1 lunch, and 1 dinner. Packs may choose to prepare their own meals in camp.

## Registration:

Each family can register by going to the calendar at [cherokeearabsa.com](http://cherokeearabsa.com).

## Check in:

Units may check in on Friday from 4:30pm until 8pm Central Time. We will be doing the fast pass again this year. More information and dates to be announced.

## Participation:

This event is open to all Lions, Tigers, Wolves, Bears, Webelos, AOLs and their families.

## Adult leadership:

Packs must have at least two adult registered leaders representing their pack. This is a council event so packs do not need their own BALOO trained leaders.

## Vehicle Information:

Parking in designated areas only. No vehicles will be allowed in the camping areas. Pack trailers will be allowed to be dropped off in designated campsites. Vehicles must be brought back to the parking lot.

## Event Rules:

The event rules are for everyone. The scout code of conduct is found in the Scout Oath, Scout Law, and the Outdoor Code.

## Trading Post:

The Trading Post will be open during this event. Hours of operation will be posted at the Admin building and the Trading Post. Cash is preferred but card purchases will be available.

## First aid:

A medic will be available all weekend in the Medical Area behind the Admin Building. Do not forget your BSA Medical form A and B for every person attending the event.

## Smoking/Vaping:

The only area adults are allowed to use for smoking is the parking away from the Archery Range. Thank you for reminding your parents to follow this strictly.

## Vespers:

A scout is reverent. All scouts and leaders are welcome to attend our Sunday morning service at the chapel.

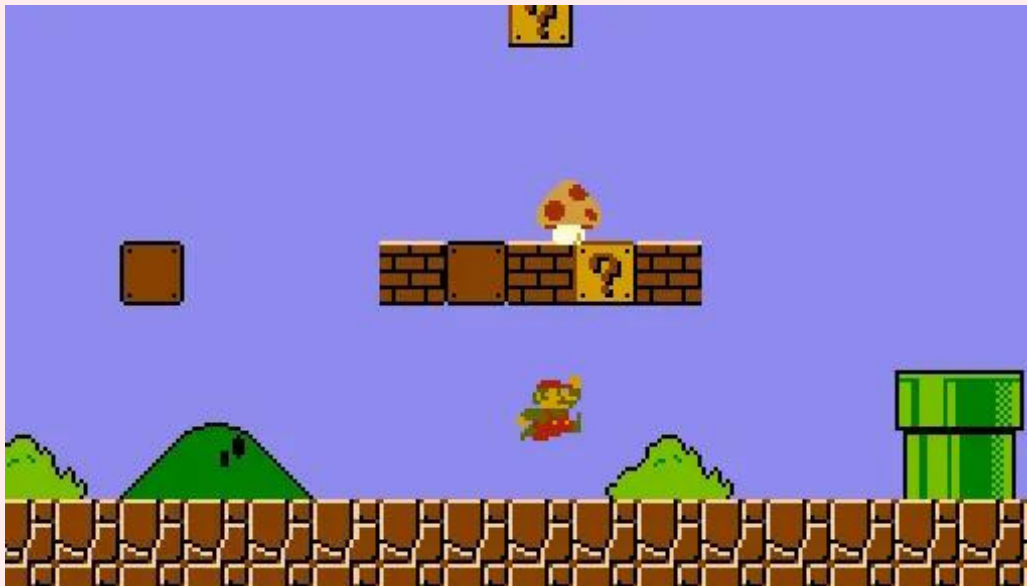

- Safety pins

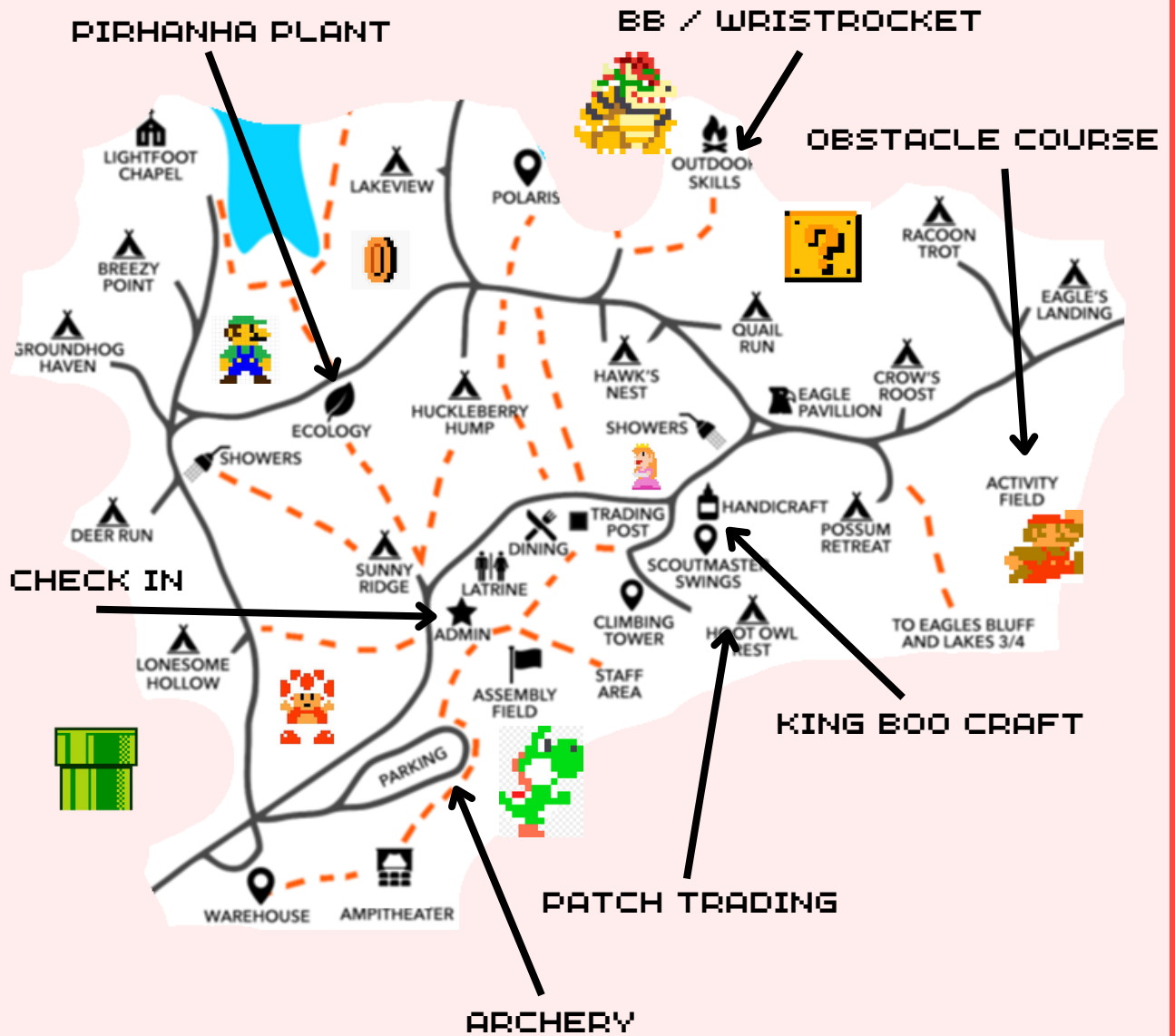

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# DO's and DON'Ts
