EVENT FEES & REGISTRATION:

REGISTRATION IS \$20 FOR EACH CUB SCOUT, PARENT/GUARDIAN, CUB LEADER, OR SIBLING. (SIBLINGS UNDER 5 YEARS OLD ARE FREE)

MEALS:

THE DINING HALL WILL BE OPEN, AND MEAL PLANS MUST BE PURCHASED IN ADVANCE FOR AN ADDITIONAL FEE OF \$15 PER PERSON. YOU WILL GET 2 BREAKFASTS, 1 LUNCH, AND 1 DINNER. PACKS MAY ALSO CHOOSE TO PREPARE THEIR OWN MEALS IN THEIR CAMPSITE.

CHECK IN:

UNITS MAY CHECK IN ON FRIDAY FROM 4:00PM — 8:00PM CENTRAL TIME. WE WILL ALSO HAVE THE ULTRA FAST PASS SYSTEM WHERE FAMILIES CAN GO DIRECT TO THEIR CAMPSITE IF ALL PAPERWORK IS TURNED IN AHEAD OF TIME. DETAILS ARE FURTHER INTO THIS GUIDE.

PARTICIPATION:

THIS EVENT IS OPEN TO ALL LIONS, TIGERS, WOLVES, BEARS, WEBELOS, AOLS AND THEIR LEGAL PARENTS/GUARDIANS & SIBLINGS.

ADULT LEADERSHIP:

THIS IS A COUNCIL EVENT SO PACKS DO NOT NEED THEIR OWN BALOO TRAINED LEADERS.

VEHICLE INFORMATION:

PARK IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY. PACK TRAILERS WILL BE ALLOWED TO BE DROPPED OFF IN DESIGNATED CAMPSITES. VEHICLES MUST BE BROUGHT BACK TO THE PARKING LOT.

NO VEHICLES WILL BE ALLOWED TO REMAIN IN THE CAMPING AREAS.

SMOKING/VAPING:

THE ONLY AREA ADULTS ARE ALLOWED TO USE FOR SMOKING IS THE PARKING LOT AWAY FROM THE ARCHERY RANGE.
THANK YOU FOR REMINDING YOUR PARENTS TO FOLLOW THIS STRICTLY.

TRADING POST:

THE TRADING POST WILL BE OPEN DURING THIS EVENT. HOURS OF OPERATION WILL BE POSTED AT THE ADMIN BUILDING AND AT THE TRADING POST. THE TRADING POST ACCEPTS CASH OR CREDIT CARD (EXCEPT AMEX).

VESPERS:

A SCOUT IS REVERENT. ALL SCOUTS AND LEADERS ARE HIGHLY ENCOURAGED TO ATTEND OUR SUNDAY MORNING SERVICE AT LIGHTFOOT CHAPEL WITH BOBBY FLECK AND ERIC PINKSTON AS CHAPLAINS.

DETAILS

RANGE & TARGETS ACTIVITY WAIVER:

ALL SCOUTS & ADDITIONAL YOUTH PARTICIPATING IN OUR RANGE & TARGET ACTIVITIES WILL NEED A SIGNED WAIVER. THAT WAIVER CAN BE FOUND ON THE REGISTRATION PAGE FOR THIS EVENT.

MEDICAL SERVICES:

THE SKYMONT CAMP MEDIC IS LOCATED AT THE ADMINISTRATION BUILDING IN THE HEALTH LODGE. THE CAMP MEDIC IS ON-CALL 24 HOURS A DAY FOR EMERGENCIES. THE CAMP MEDIC IS IN PLACE FOR BASIC FIRST-AID AND TO EVALUATE EMERGENCIES, BUT WILL NOT PROVIDE OR TREAT ROUTINE OR CHRONIC HEALTHCARE CONDITIONS. THE NEAREST HOSPITALS ARE SOUTHERN TENNESSEE REGIONAL HEALTH SYSTEMS IN SEWANEE, TN, OR UNITY MEDICAL CENTER IN MANCHESTER, TN. BOTH ARE WITHIN 45 MINUTES OF CAMP. PACKS MUST PROVIDE THEIR OWN TRANSPORTATION FOR ALL OFF-SITE MEDICAL CARE UNLESS THE CAMP MEDIC DETERMINES THAT AN EMERGENCY VEHICLE IS MEDICALLY NECESSARY. THERE IS NO ELECTRICAL SERVICE IN CAMPSITES AND GENERATORS ARE NOT PERMITTED. TROOPS MUST BE PREPARED TO PROVIDE BATTERY POWER FOR ANY AND ALL MEDICAL DEVICES IF NEEDED. RECHARGING IS AVAILABLE AT SCOUTMASTER SWINGS.

WILDLIFE AWARENESS:

SKYMONT SITS ON OVER 2200 ACRES OF WILDERNESS ALONG THE CUMBERLAND PLATEAU AND IS HOME TO A WIDE VARIETY OF WILDLIFE. ALL WILDLIFE AT SKYMONT IS CONSIDERED TO BE UNTAMED AND IN THEIR NATURAL HABITAT. SCOUTS SHOULD EXERCISE THE PRINCIPLES OF OUTDOOR ETHICS WHILE ON CAMP. WILDLIFE SHOULD BE LEFT UNDISTURBED AT ALL TIMES. IF WILDLIFE ENTER THE CAMP AREA AND BECOME A NUISANCE OR A THREAT, SAFELY EVACUATE THE AREA AND NOTIFY THE CAMP RANGER.

GENERAL CLEANLINESS:

A SCOUT IS CLEAN. EACH PACK SHOULD BRING ITS TRASH TO THE TRASH TRAILER BEHIND THE DINING HALL.

TRASH SHOULD BE SECURED TIGHTLY TO AVOID SPILLS AND LITTERING DURING TRANSPORT. SCOUTS SHOULD NOT WEAR WET OR SOILED CLOTHING INTO THE DINING HALL.

SHOWERS & LATRINES:

MOST CAMPSITES AT SKYMONT ARE OUTFITTED WITH A BATHHOUSE FEATURING 3 FLUSH TOILETS, A TROUGH SINK, AND 2 PRIVATE SHOWERS, ALONG WITH A TANKLESS WATER HEATER WHICH CAN BE CONNECTED TO A PROPANE CYLINDER (TO BE PROVIDED BY THE UNIT AND CONNECTED BY THE CAMP RANGER OR CAMP COMMISSIONERS) TO SUPPLY HOT WATER TO THE SHOWERS. LEADERS MUST RESPECT THE PRIVACY OF SCOUTS IN SITUATIONS SUCH AS SHOWERING AND INTRUDE ONLY TO THE EXTENT THAT HEALTH AND SAFETY REQUIRES. PACKS SHOULD BE PREPARED TO SUPPLY GARBAGE BAGS, PAPER TOWELS. AND SOAP FOR THE LATRINE IN THEIR CAMPSITE.



EAST PASS

We are SO excited to make your check-in process even EASIER for camp this Fall! For Packs who turn in all A-B Med Forms & RATA Waivers prior to arriving at camp, your families will be able to check in while still in their car and head STRAIGHT to your campsite to unload!

UNIT LEADERS: Please gather all of your forms and bring them to the Scout Service Center on either October 14 or 15 from 5p to 7p for Weekend 1. OR October 21 or 22 for Weekend 2. A link will be emailed out for you to set your appointment time.

ONCE AT CAMP: Families will be stopped just before the entrance into Main Camp and checked in while still in their cars! They'll receive their wristbands and a camp map to help them on their way. They'll be able to drive straight into their campsite, unload, and bring their vehicle back to the parking area before setting up!

FOR THOSE NOT USING FAST PASS: You will still be stopped, registration checked, and then asked to proceed to the parking lot to check-in in the admin building.

PACK CHECK-IN: One leader from each Pack will still need to stop by admin for your packet & t-shirt orders.




