

OFFICIAL RACER RULES

INSPECTION CHECKLIST

WEIGHT

1. Weight will not be over 5.000 ounces by official scale.

CAR MEASUREMENTS

2. Entire car (including wheels, axles, block, and decorations) will be 2.75 inches wide or less, 7 inches long or less, and 5 inches tall or less.
3. Width between the wheels is 1.75 inches minimum.
4. Bottom clearance between car and track is 3/8".

WHEELS AND AXLES

5. Cars will use the pre-cut axle slots. Axle slots can also be recut and moved on the block, as long as the wheelbase remains equal to the original wheelbase of 4 5/16 inches. A variance of up to 3/16 of an inch will be allowed.
6. No bearings, washers, bushings, or springs. Free-wheeling, no "devices".
7. Cars must run on 4 standard derby plastic wheels, using standard derby nails or axles and be installed in such a way as to keep the car in it's race assigned lane.
8. Only dry lubricants, like graphite, are allowed.

OTHER RULES

9. If any car has modifications that go against the "spirit" of the traditional race, officials may require changes during check-in.
10. Officials reserve the right to allow some exceptions within the "spirit" of the traditional race.
