## WHAT TO DO NOW THAT I AM HERE?

- 3. Walk to your campsite, set-up your tent, and stow your belongings.
- 4. Prepare supper in your campsite or come to the Trading Post to purchase burgers, hot dogs, drinks, and other food items.
- 5. Please social distance as much as possible & wear face mask when you feel it is needed.

### **IMPORTANT SAFETY RULES**

#### Cars:

- No parking on the roads, your help is appreciated
- Speed limit is 10 MPH Keep cars slow
- No riding in the back of pick-ups

### Campsites:

- One campfire per entire campsite tended by an adult
- No open flames in tents
- Place bags of trash on side of road before leaving camp.

- First Aid Station located at the Dining Hall
