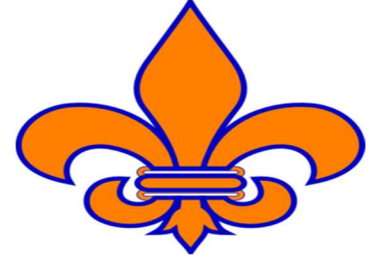




UT Martin Merit Badge Workshop

Veterinarian Medicine, Animal Science, and Farm Mechanics will be eating in their rooms so lunch must be brought from home.
