BASIC ADULT LEADER OUTDOOR ORIENTATION

Why BALOO?

Every pack that camps overnight—for pack, district, or even council events—is required to have a BALOO trained leader onsite the entire duration of the event.

Who should take this training?

All Cubmasters, Assistant Cubmasters, Den Leaders, and Committee members are encouraged to take this training.

This session will follow the full syllabus, giving participants a unique hands-on experience so they can confidently conduct a safe and successful overnight camping experience for their Cub Scouts. Participants will have the opportunity to work as a team with other scouters across the council. As noted above, a pack MUST have at least BALOO-trained leader present at all times when the pack is camping. Because things can happen, it is advisable to have several BALOO-trained leaders in each pack. You would hate for the pack to miss out if the only BALOO-trained leader can't be there.
