•	Above the church main doors there are 3 letters that stand for something in Latin. When translated to English means "Jesus, Savior of Men". What are the 3 letters?
•	Inside the church, there is a statue donated by Marie K. Barrett. The statue is very well done. Who is the statue of?
•	Inside the church, there is a display of 3 oils. The first (top) is oil of catechumen, the second oil (middle) is the sacred chrism for confirmation and ordinations, and the third oil (bottom) is the oil of infirm used for anointing of the sick. Each container has a symbol on the glass. Without touching the oil containers, write down the symbols of each container.
