- Extra socks
- Extra shoes

Who's in Charge?

Parents and guardians are the superheroes responsible for supervising their Scouts throughout the weekend.

If a parent cannot attend, another designated adult (not a den leader) must be responsible for the Scout.

For everyone's safety, no adult should supervise more than one Scout in addition to their own child.

Camp Rules — Keep It Cool!

- Live by the Scout Oath and Scout Law.
- Stay with your buddy and your Pack.
- Adults supervise Scouts at all times.
- Respect other campers and their belongings.
- Practice Leave No Trace principles.
- No vehicles in camping areas.
- No ground fires.
- Cub Scouts may not use axes or hatchets.
- Saws must be used safely under adult supervision.
- No weapons or fireworks.
- No photography near restroom or shower facilities.
- Closed-toe shoes are highly encouraged during activities.
- Most importantly...have fun and make amazing memories!

Weather & Safety

Camp is held **rain or shine**. Activities may be adjusted if severe weather creates unsafe conditions.

Certified medical personnel and emergency procedures are available throughout the weekend should the need arise.

We'll gather for popcorn, cheese and crackers, cookies, and other treats while everyone relaxes, shares stories from the day, and enjoys time with fellow Scouting families.
