



BSA Paddle Craft Safety expands Safety Afloat training to include the skills, as well as the knowledge, required for a unit leader to assess whether or not they are qualified to supervise a canoeing or kayaking activity. Persons completing the training will have the opportunity to learn the skills to safely launch and maneuver a canoe or kayak along with planning and rescue techniques.

This is the training for canoeing 1) Basic. The training module are open to any registered adult leader, Scout, Varsity, or Venturer, who is age 15 or older. The Basic Module Paddle Craft Safety is a prerequisite to the River (moving water) Module. We will NOT be offering the moving water module at this time.

The trainings are conducted by council approved ACA instructors, takes roughly 8 hours and is valid for three years. You must be able to pass and be classified as a BSA swimmer to take this class and pass the final written test to get the card and badge.

Bring your BSA medical form parts A, B required, and C if you have it, swimsuit, sunscreen, a long sleeve shirt for UV protection, towel, water shoes (not crocs). You may also wish to bring a wetsuit (optional) Lake water temps could be in the 70's but air temps could be in the 60's.
