



## Top Shot Competition

Each troop forms a team of youth made up of their best shooters in rifle (.22), archery, shotgun (20ga), and water gun to participate in unique shooting sports competition. The archery, rifle, and shotgun competitions will use provided targets, best cumulative score wins. Range masters will serve as the judges and have final say.

All materials will be camp supplied. Shooters may provide their own safety eye protection and hearing protection. Shotgun shooters are restricted to those Scouts who are strong enough to hold the shotgun.

### Rules

- Archery – Participant shoots a bow and arrow (five (5) arrows) at standard 80cm target.
- Rifle Shooting – Shooter fires five rounds at paper target.
- Shotgun Shooting – Shooter takes five shots at clay targets.
- Water Gun – Participant is to snuff out a candle from 10 feet.


### Scoring

- Archery – Cumulative score of five arrows on target.
- Rifle Shooting – Cumulative score of five shots on paper target.
- Shotgun Shooting – 10 points for each clay target hit.
- Water Gun – Subtract total number of shots taken to snuff candle.
