

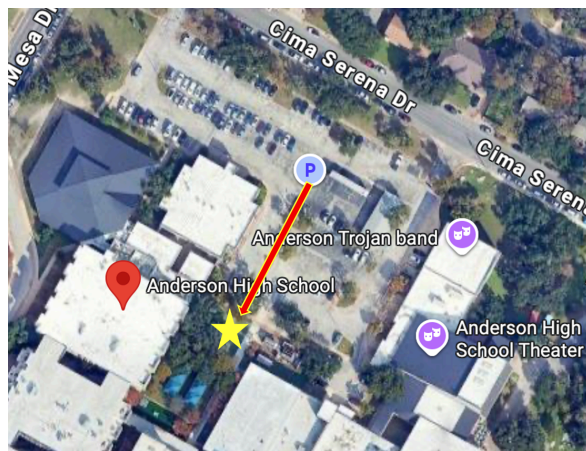
Welcome to TechLab Space camp families! Are your campers ready to blast off into a whole different environment? We have prepared so many fun activities for your campers this year and look forward to seeing you on Monday! Camp runs 9am-3:30pm, Monday - Friday.

#### Pickup/Drop off

Pickup and Drop off is from the **courtyard adjacent to the parking lot off of Cima Serena**. You are needed for the initial check-in on Monday so please park and walk your camper in. We have 80-100 campers to get checked in so please plan accordingly and bring your patience. To that end **we cannot accept any campers before 8am** and opening ceremonies start at 9am (Mondays are our exception depending on how quickly we get everyone checked in)

On the other side of the moon, pick up will be from the same location. Camp ends at 3:30 and **ALL CAMPERS must be picked up by 5:00 pm** (please note this is a change from the previous time of 5:30). Extended care will be outside in the courtyard this year.

If you need to pick your camper up **early or drop them off late** please **come to the courtyard and call Jessica Snider at 512-632-9395**. We will send someone to get you. Please DO NOT walk over to the ATC without camp staff.

On Monday you will need to bring a **COMPLETED and PRINTED** copy of the **BSA med form** for each camper (and all volunteers) even if they have attended a prior week. You can find the form at [https://filestore.scouting.org/filestore/HealthSafety/pdf/680-001\\_AB.pdf](https://filestore.scouting.org/filestore/HealthSafety/pdf/680-001_AB.pdf). These forms (A, B1 and B2) are required to attend camp. At check in your camper will get their t-shirt and name tag after their med form is turned in. Lines can be long so please plan accordingly and be patient.

**The t-shirt they receive on Monday is our camp uniform** and MUST be worn EVERY day to camp, along with closed-toe shoes. The following are the only exceptions.

1. Tuesday: Any past years TechLab T-Shirt or any Space Themed Shirt
2. Thursday: Any past years TechLab T-Shirt or any Space Themed Shirt

For safety our welding and woodworking class will need pants and long sleeves in the morning. They are welcome to bring a change of clothes for the rest of their day.

#### What to bring to camp:

1. Medical Form (details above)
2. Closedtoed shoes
3. A sack lunch

4. A positive attitude.

We have much less space to refrigerate lunches this year so it is imperative that if your camper's **lunch needs to be** kept cool you pack it in a **LABELED ZIP-LOCK LIKE BAG**. We do not have room for lunch boxes and will have to assume they have good lasting ice packs in them and will leave them in the group wagon. Lunch is from 11:30am-1pm.

There is **NO HOT LUNCH** this year.

What not to bring to camp:

1. Firearms (not even toy ones)
2. Pocket knives, axes or any other sharp object
3. Electronics (your camper may have a phone but we expect it to be kept stored away in their bag or pocket)

Please plan to join us at 3:30pm on Friday afternoon for our Parent Day Open House. Your campers can show you some of the cool things they accomplished this week. We will be done by 4:30pm.
