NYLT-Wood Badge-Powder Horn Financial Assistance Process and Procedure

Any individual requesting financial assistance to enroll in one of Circle Ten Council's ADLC programs must first do the following:

- 1. Be a registered scouter or scout in the Circle Ten Council
- 2. Register for the desired course in the registration system of Circle Ten Council, Black Pug.
- 3. Pay 50% of the fee for the course
- 4. Obtain the application form from their course director (who can request from the ALDC senior leadership)
- 5. Attach a copy of the Black Pug receipt of registration
- 6. Submit the signed and completed course form to their course director
- 7. The course director will submit to the ALDC chair either in person or via email (C10ALDC@gmail.com)

Process

- 1. Upon receipt, the ALDC chair will confer with the appropriate program coordinator and course director
- 2. If approved, the ALDC Chair will sign and submit to the Circle Ten Council Professional who supports the ALDC for processing.
- 3. The Course Director will be notified and will then notify the participant of the decision to support or not support.
- 4. If a decision is made not to support, the ALDC chair will provide a written response as to the reason(s) for the decision.
