
Transportation

Check In Procedures

- Gate opens at Noon but plan to arrive at your check in time

- 1 adult to Dining Hall with
 - Adult forms (YPT, In state compliance, Texas Registered sex offender search result, 1 weather hazard training form)
 - All AHMR forms alphabetical by last name
 - Non-Circle Ten Council units bring two (2) copies of their local council insurance claim form.
 - Pick up welcome packet

- 6:00 Supper
- 7:00 Scoutmaster/SPL meeting at Commissioners Cove
- 8:15 Opening night campfire at Amphitheatre
- 10:00 Taps





Vehicles on Camp

- All Vehicles reside in the parking lot, except
 - Handicap (need hanger from Medical)
 - Some Staff (kitchen, Quartermaster, etc.)
 - Trailers or
 - 1 truck with trailer permanently attached
 - May not move all week
 - Only Kitchen staff behind Dining Hall
- Troops may have 1 vehicle at a time to load/unload
 - Scouts should walk
 - Vehicles out of campsite by 6pm Sunday
