

Camp Staff Boot Camp



An introduction to serving on Camp Staff!

For Scouts who are interested in working at 2024 Summer Camp.

Option #1 (Registering and camping with your Troop)

Register with your troop in Black Pug as a “Camp Staff Boot Camp Option #1” participant at Campsgiving. The Scout will arrive with the troop and check in with the troop as normal. The Scout will sign up for 3 hours per day of Merit Badge classes. The Scout will be assigned to program areas where they will experience merit badge preparation, instruction, paperwork completion, and reporting attendance and completion of requirements in Black Pug. Scouts will be assigned to campfire programs, learn camp songs, dining hall prep and clean up, food service, flag ceremonies, and evening program events, and will sit with the staff during meals.

Option #2 (Individual Registration)

Scouts will register in Black Pug as a “Camp Staff Boot Camp Option #2” participant at Campsgiving. The Staffer will arrive on Friday evening and be assigned to staff housing. If the Staffer/youth is under 18 they must be dropped off by a parent or legal guardian where on-site paperwork will be collected from the parent or legal guardian. The Staffer will register for 3 hours per day of Merit Badge classes on Black Pug and be assigned to program areas and service corps where the staffer will learn and live the camp staff experience. The Staffer will help with dining hall procedures, unit service, campfire programs, songs, recording of attendance, paperwork completion, merit badge requirements in Black Pug, evening programs, flag ceremonies, and check-in and check-out procedures. Parents and legal guardians will drop off the staffer **no later than** Friday, November 17th at 7:00 p.m. Check-in for the Boot Camp Staffer is between 5:00 p.m. - 7:00 p.m. The Boot Camp Staffer will remain on camp with the rest of the staff until dismissed on Tuesday, November 22nd, at approximately 12:00 p.m. (noon).

Camp Staff Boot Camp

Requirements:

1. Be at least 15 years old by November 16th, 2023
2. Parent or Guardian permission
3. Positive Mental Attitude
4. Fully registered and booked in the on-line reservation system (Black Pug) by Monday, October 16th at 2:00 p.m.
5. Be registered as a member of the Circle Ten Council
6. Complete Class A, B and C health record
7. Completion of YPT (Youth Protection Training)
8. Workplace harassment training
9. Anti Bullying training
10. ServSafe Food Handler certificate
11. Recommendation from a unit leader

Fees:

Option #1 is \$175

Includes:

1. Staff and Camper Patch
2. Interviews with camp staff management from Circle Ten Council for 2024 season
3. Camp staff SWAG
4. Camp with Troop (own tent, etc.)

Option #2 is \$200 *limit of 20 participants

Includes:

1. Staff and Camper Patch
2. Interviews with camp staff management from Circle Ten Council for 2024 season
3. Camp staff SWAG
4. Staff living quarters (shared cabin)
5. Early arrival and all meals with staff on Friday, November 17th, from 5:00 –7:00 p.m.
6. Late departure with staff on Tuesday, November 22nd
7. Camp staff mentor

After successful completion and evaluation, the participant will be recommended to serve as camp staff at one or more of our Council Camps for the 2024 season.
