Check-In Documents

- 1. All medical forms will be handed in to the Camp Health Officer in the First Aid Lodge.
- 2. All other forms will be turned in at check-in, including:
 - a. Unit roster (must be the official roster downloaded and printed from my.scouting.org). All attendees must be listed on this roster.
 - b. Weather Hazards certificate (at least one adult must have this) Plus, for all adults:
 - c. Printed copy of a valid Youth Protection certificate
 - d. Printed copy of the Adult In-Camp State Compliance Form (HERE)
- 3. All non-Circle Ten Council units will need to bring two (2) copies of their local council insurance claim form.

Merit Badges

This allows us to maximize the amount of merit badges a scout can earn within such a short time. The wide majority of merit badges will be completed, but there will be a couple of partials due to the nature of the requirements.
