



Downloading a Scouting America Membership Card

All currently registered members of the Scouting America may download a copy of their Membership ID (card). This may be used for check-in at events and campouts. *The official roster downloaded from my.scouting.org is to be used for unit check-in.* The roster must show Membership ID numbers and proof of current membership (future expiration date).

How to download the card

Step 1: Go to my.scouting.org and log in. All individuals may set up an account to access their records.



Step 2: On the home page, click on “My Profile”.


Step 3: Scroll down to “Registrations”. You will see “Download Membership Card” on the right side.



Step 4: Click on “Download Membership Card”:

Step 5: Select the membership card(s) you wish to download and click the blue “Download” button.



Step 6: A PDF of your membership card will show onscreen. You may save to your files and/or print.

The membership ID number will be listed above the barcode.

Important: your registration expiration date will be outlined above the membership ID number and must be current.



Downloading a Scouting America Membership Card

Connecting your Scoutbook or my.scouting.org account to your Scout:

If you have a Scoutbook account or a my.scouting.org account you can attach yourself to your scout.

Step 1: Log into your my.scouting.org account credentials

Step 2: My Dashboard -> Administration -> My Account -> My Connections and

Step 3: click the new “Connect to your Scout” link.

The search requires the Scout’s Member ID, last name, zip code (as recorded in my.scouting.org and/or Scoutbook) and date of birth.

Once the Scout is found and confirmed, you will be connected to your Scout with Full Control. Your unit leaders can give you the member ID for your Scout.
