SWR - Open to all adults. Knowledge of lifeguard skills is helpful, but not required. All participants must have the swimmers tag and Safe Swim Defense and Safety Afloat training (on-line). Swimming & Water Rescue expands the awareness instruction provided by Safe Swim Defense and includes information and skill to prevent, recognize, and respond to swimming emergencies during unit swimming activities. Council permits SWR holders to conduct swimmer classification testing.
