A SCOUT IS REVERENT AWARD

Under the guidance of a unit's Chaplain's Aide, each camper at a Circle Ten Long Term Camp may work to fulfill the requirements of the council's, "A Scout is Reverent" award. After completing the requirements, the patch may be purchased.

The Requirements are:

1. Attend a worship service if offered at their camp. In the event, that the camp does not offer a worship service, the unit may conduct a Scout's Own service or vesper service on its own or in conjunction with other units.
2. Lead grace before a meal or other event. This can be done at a camp-wide meal or the unit's campsite. To permit youth to fulfill this requirement, adults seeking the award should refrain from leading grace at camp-wide meals but ought to lead grace in the unit's campsite.
3. Scouts BSA, Venturing, and Sea Scouts: Participate in at least three devotional activities, either by preparing and delivering a devotional or attending the devotional. It is preferred that this occur within the unit at its campsite. Adults may complete this requirement by assisting youth in preparing devotionals.
4. With an adult leader, discuss the importance of the twelfth point of the Scout Law – "A Scout is Reverent." Discuss how it applies to you here at summer camp and in your daily life.
5. Become informed about the Religious Award for your faith:

Youth: Learn about the Religious Emblem of their faith and age group. If the Scout has already earned their faith's Religious Emblem, help explain the award program to another youth.

Adults: Commit to help make a Religious Emblems program presentation at a unit meeting or serve as a Religious Emblems Counselor for your faith community.

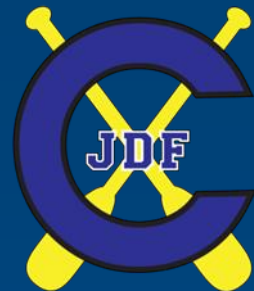
TREK Program

- **Awards Earned**

 - 15 years of age, Swimmer, Health Form ABC
- **Camp Provides**
 - Meals, Canoes, Water Purification, Snorkeling Gear





Check-in Procedures



- Gate Opens at noon
- Arrive at your check in time to avoid congestion
 - Early troops will be held at the gate until their time
- Park Trailer and Troop in parking lot
- Scoutmaster and SPL check in at Dining Hall, troop goes on tour with troop guide
- Trailer goes to campsite during tour
- Troops sharing campsites have assigned tents via tape
- Troop ends tour at aquatics take swim checks, turn in swim check paperwork, and receive wristband
- Troop unpacks at campsite
- Flags and Dinner at 5:45 p.m.

- **Always have a buddy**

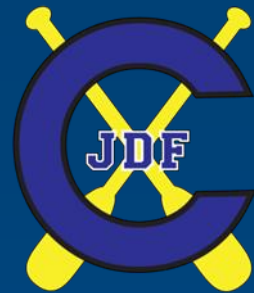

Troop Swim Checks



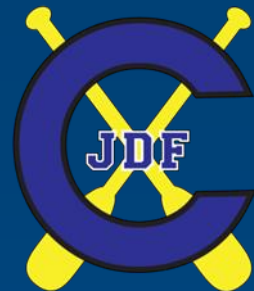
- **OK to do before you come to camp**

- **Follow BSA Swim Classification procedure**
 - on Registration page
 - Bring a copy to camp
 - Keep a copy for the Troop
 - Camp will issue arm bands accordingly
 - Do include copy of tester certification
 - No ID required

- Table Waiters Arrive 15 minutes prior to meals to get silverware, cups, drinks, etc.

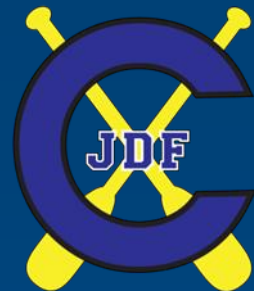

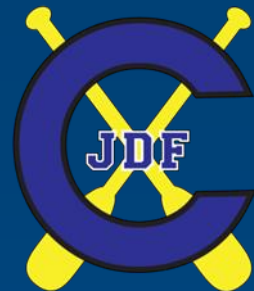

- **Active Adult Supervision**
 - At Bathhouses, Dining Hall, and Program Areas
- **2 Deep Leadership**
 - In campsites and around camp (no one-on-one contact)
- **Buddy System**
 - No Scout should be “touring” camp alone
- **Bullying/YPT**
 - **See Something, Say Something**
 - Report directly to camp leadership (Camp Director, Asst. Camp Director, Program Director, Commissioner)

- All visitors must be off camp by 11:00 p.m. Visitors may not stay overnight.
- Cost: \$10 per person (covers insurance, food). Payments for this visit are non-refundable and are required even if not eating.

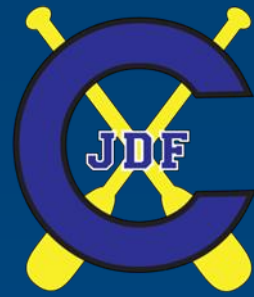
