3. Registration & Payment

- Register by unit only (separate registrations for boy & girl troops).
- Two-deep leadership required; minimum of two registered adults per unit on-camp at all times.
- All information entered, class selected, and paid in full by November 16 at 11:00 p.m.

- > BSA Annual Health & Medical Record Parts A & B for each participant.
- > Weather Hazards Training certificate for at least one adult leader.

Swim Tests

Submit your Unit Swim Classification Record before camp. On-site swim tests are available after breakfast before a unit's first aquatic activity.

Water Safety

- Wristbands: BLUE (Swimmer), RED (Beginner), WHITE (Non-Swimmer/Non-Participant), YELLOW (Staff).
- Always use the Buddy System & buddy tags.
- Beginners & Non-Swimmers may canoe or take boat rides to Hell's Gate.

8. Accommodations & Packing

Accommodations

- Units provide their own tents.
- Campsites assigned by staff based on attendance and camp needs.

Suggested Packing List

- Label all personal items!
- Uniform & weather-appropriate clothing for 4 days
- Sleeping bag or blankets (overnight lows ~40-50 °F)
- Tent & ground tarp
- Reusable water bottle (≥1 L)
- Personal first-aid kit & medications
- Rain gear & extra socks
- Flashlight/headlamp with spare batteries
- Toiletries & towel
- Notebook, pen, merit-badge prerequisites
