Registration Information

Cuboree is open to all Cub Scouts and their adult family member/guardian. Siblings and non-scouts who are related to the Cub Scout may attend on Saturday only with the Scout and the adult family member/guardian. Please note that the activities will be outdoors and geared to Cub Scouts in grades Kindergarten -5^{th} grade.

Campsites will be assigned by event staff. Every effort will be made to keep packs together at one site. Only Scouts and adults from the same household may tent together during this event.

Cub Scouts camping overnight must be accompanied by an adult/parent/guardian -1 per scout (unless there is more than 1 scout in the family)

This is tent camping only, no campers or RV's will be allowed.

Parking: In designated parking areas only. Absolutely no vehicles other than those attached to trailers may be left in campsites without a special permit from the Cuboree Camp Staff. Please follow all directions from staff and signs posted.

Check-in Procedure

One adult from the pack should check in and turn in the medical forms for the pack and pick up schedules/maps at Check-In. Forms may be kept in the notebook/envelope provided and will be returned on Sunday morning after the campsite has been checked after the Scouts Own.

All forms must be properly filled out and signed. There will be no exceptions.

Please bring a roster of participants to turn in at check-in or be prepared to fill one out at check-in.

Water: Available at the camp. Each participant and staff member should have a personal water bottle.

Garbage: There is a dumpster located near the dining hall. Try to pack food products to have as little trash as possible.

Meals: Each pack is responsible for their own meals. The person(s) responsible for cooking should take the food handler course.

Health/Safety/First Aid: Minor first aid is the adult/parent/guardian's responsibility. Major first aid problems will be handled by Cuboree first aid staff.

Radios, boom boxes, bicycles, two-way radios, guns, fireworks, fixed blade knives, axes, hatchets, chain saws, PETS, and alcoholic beverages are NOT allowed. Basically, anything that could be a safety concern for our participants or a nuisance to others should **NOT** be brought to this event.

All Scouting America and Circle Ten Council campground policies must be followed. Smoking is not permitted in the camp. If you must smoke, please use your personal vehicle in the parking lot.

Campfires are only permitted in established fire rings. Units may NOT dig new fire pits.

Be sure all campfires are completely out (no heat/embers) before leaving the campsite for activities, retiring for the night, and before you check out on Sunday. A fire check will be done and you will be asked to extinguish the fire if no one is tending it.
