Your skills with a black powder rifle will be tested at our egg shoot. Sharpen your skill with a throwing hawk at the Card Corner Challenge. Survival cooking skills will be tested on the overnighter to Fort Bridger and then use your trail marking skills to help you get back. Learn the skill of tanning a hide, a critical skill a Mountain Man used to trade for goods with the Indians & civilized man. Blacksmithing will be a cornerstone skill in the Extreme Mountain Man program and your Scouts will learn what it takes to make a knife and sheath, their own flint and steel fire starting kit and build a long-term shelter on the frontier. The extreme mountain man will also be called upon to teach some of these new skills to a younger Scout. This is an all-day program - Scouts will NOT have time for merit badges. Scouts MUST be 15 or older. Cost for this program includes a breakfast and a dinner that they will eat in the area (total of 2 meals).




