# UPON ARRIVAL

## CHECK-IN & ARRIVAL

**Friday, April 24, 6:30 p.m. at Daffron Pavilion**

### Required at check-in:

- Unit Roster (preferred from my.scouting.org)
- Annual Health & Medical Record Parts A & B
  - These will be *verified* but not *collected*.

Camping is optional and available Friday and/or Saturday night. Packs will be assigned to a campsite together.

**UNIT CHECK-IN:** Adult leaders will check in with the Camp Staff with their attending pack roster and get their campsite assignments. Adults may drive the Scouts and equipment to the camp sites to unload. Vehicles will then need to be removed to the parking area as quickly as possible. ALL vehicles must be out of the campsite area by 9:30 pm

**CAMP MAP:** Camp Wisdom Map will be available at check-in.

**MEALS: No food provided**—Each Pack is responsible for their own meals and cooking gear. Pack meals will be served in the Pack’s campsite.

**PARKING:** Designated parking is available for all vehicles and trailers. **No parking at campsites.** For special needs, contact event staff in advance.

**SETTING UP CAMP:** Campsites will host around 50 people. Pack leaders should coordinate with Scouts to efficiently use shared space. “A Scout is courteous!” No digging of large holes is permitted. Please do not overpack equipment.

*Please note that Campsites may be shared with other Packs.*

**RESTROOMS:** Packs must clean their assigned restrooms before departure on Sunday. Remove trash from floors, take out the trash bags, and leave facilities cleaner than when found.

## IMPORTANT REMINDERS

## NOTEWORTHY INFORMATION

### SWIMMING

There will be no swimming at this event.

### BE PREPARED

Shared campsites include fire rings. You may bring an above-ground fire pit or grill for campfires and cooking.

### TRADING POST:

Will not be open during this event.

**SEVERE WEATHER:**

If severe weather threatens, updates will be sent via contact information from unit registration. **The dining hall will serve as the emergency shelter.**

**HYDRATION:**

Bring your own water bottle or cup with a carabiner for Saturday activities. Refill stations will be available at each activity.

**FLASHLIGHTS:**

Bring a flashlight, especially for exploring cave areas.
