

Adult and Youth NYLT Staff Requirements

- All staff must be registered with a Scouting America Program.
- All staff must register and pay the staff course fee
- All adult staff shall attend an adult orientation meeting (date TBD)
- All staff must complete Scouting America's Safeguarding Youth Training.
- All staff must complete Scouting America's Peer on Peer Abuse Training.
- All staff shall take Fundamentals Part 1: Science of Training (D70)
- All adult staff must have current Hazardous Weather Training
- All staff must provide an Annual Health and Medical Record Parts A, B, and C valid through the end of course weekend #2.
- The Course Director, Backup Course Director, Scoutmasters, and Assistant Scoutmasters must have completed Wood Badge as a participant.

Staff Expectations

- All adult staff are expected to abide by the Scouter Code of Conduct.
- All staff are expected to abide by the NYLT Code of Conduct.
- All staff share responsibility for creating a high energy and positive learning environment for staff and participants
- Attend Staff Development Meetings (SDMs)
- Attend full course weekends
- Notify NYLT Course Director of any problems with attendance or participation ASAP.
- "Be Prepared" - ensure that all staff assignments are completed on time and to the best of your abilities.
- NYLT staff assignment/position is based upon the needs of the course.
