Scouting works best when youth are safe. That's why Scouting America requires all parents and leaders to complete **SAFE Guarding Youth Training**. The good news? It's online, free, and takes about 90 minutes the first year.

Who Needs This Training?

- All new parents or guardians
- All registered adult leaders
- Anyone helping with activities, events, or camping

What Is SAFE Guarding Youth?

This training helps parents understand how Scouting keeps youth safe, how to recognize and prevent unsafe situations, how to report concerns properly, and expectations for adult behavior in Scouting.

How to Take the Training

1. **Create a Scouting account:** Go to my.scouting.org and click Create Account.
2. **Log in:** Return to my.scouting.org and sign in.
3. **Start the training:** Menu ■ → My Training → SAFE Guarding Youth → Launch.
4. **Finish & save:** Complete all sections and save your certificate.
