Who Needs This Training?

All Direct Contact Leaders* are required to complete Hazardous Weather Training every 730 days (2 years) to be considered “trained” in their position and is encouraged for everyone.

Why This Training Matters

The Scouting America Hazardous Weather Training is exclusively offered online and helps keep Scouts and leaders safe during severe and changing weather conditions encountered during Scouting activities.

How to Complete the Training

Step 1 – Log In or create an account and then log in to My.Scouting.org

Step 2 – Select “My Training” in the middle of the page to the right of your name

Step 3 – Navigate to Hazardous Weather Training

- Registered Direct Contact Leaders* will find Hazardous Weather Training status directly under the Safeguarding Youth Training bar near the top/middle of the page
- If you do not see Hazardous Weather Training there, select “**Expanded Learning**”, then “**Program Safety**”, and then scroll down to about the middle of the page

Step 4 – Select the 28-minute Hazardous Weather Training Course and get started

Step 5 – Complete the Course and Confirm Training Record

Important Notes

- Hazardous Weather Training expires every 730 days (2 years) and should be current to participate in outdoor activities
- Strongly recommended annually and before high-risk weather seasons
- Complements Safeguarding Youth Training, BALOO & IOLS Trainings
