Merit badge registration opens on March 1 for weeks 1 and 2, and on March 15 for weeks 3, 4, and 5. Units will sign their Scouts up for badges through Black Pug, our online registration system. We suggest making use of the Parent Portal option to allow your scouts' parents to assist in that process.
