

CUSTOMIZE YOUR EXPERIENCE

Weekend Experiences start at just \$6 per Scout. Additional costs, per Scout, are outlined below, and include fees for programming upgrades, experienced instructors, and camping.

FISHING	\$6	Includes fishing rods, tackle and bait.
SWIMMING*	\$6	Lake Dillon is open year-round.
NATURE	\$6	Includes programming materials.
RANGE & TARGET SPORTS*		Archery is \$15, Rifle is \$20, and Shotgun is \$25 per Scout.
S.T.E.M.	\$15	Includes materials for exploring robotics.
CLIMBING & RAPPELLING*	\$20	Includes climbing safety equipment.
COPE*	\$20	Includes use of the Council COPE Challenge Course.
BOATING	\$10	Includes use of Council rowboats and canoes, as well as personal floatation devices.
SPORTS & PERSONAL FITNESS	\$6	Includes the use of Council equipment, such as Ultimate Frisbees, balls, etc.
WELDING*	\$10	Includes the use of Council equipment .

Support staff will be provided at your request for any of our Weekend Experience activities at \$50. * These activities require at least one support staff / Director at \$50.



CAMPING

It's not a Scout outing without roasting s'mores around a campfire! Whether you're looking to rough it in the outdoors or just want a little more comfort, we have five different camping options for you:

TENT CAMPING AT CUB ADVENTURE CAMP & CAMP FLEET	Bring your own tent and gear! Water and restrooms are nearby. \$3 per person, per night.
TENT CAMPING AT T. BRADY SAUNDERS	Tent platforms, bath houses and restrooms are on-site. \$5 per person, per night.
MOUNTAIN CABINS	For Scouts who aren't yet ready to tent camp, we have 3 mountain cabins available, each sleeping 24. \$10 per person, per night.
YURTS	We have 2 spacious yurts available, each sleeping 16. \$10 per person, per night.
WESTERN FORT	The fort includes 10 rooms, each sleeping 6, along with restrooms equipped with showers. \$10 per person, per night.
