- Jamboree is an adventure that will challenge you to go farther than you ever thought possible. But you can. And you will.







NATIONAL SCOUT JAMBOREE - ATTENDING

CONTINGENT UNITS

- Scouts attend via Contingent units of 36 Scouts formed by the Heart of Virginia Council Jamboree Committee
- Contingent units will prepare, travel, & camp together

YOUTH QUALIFICATIONS

Scouts BSA

- MUST have a current BSA membership with a Scouts BSA troop.
- MUST be at least a First Class Scout by the first day of the Jamboree (July 19, 2023).
- MUST be at least 12 years of age by the first day of the Jamboree (July 19, 2023) and not reached their 21st birthday by the last day of the Jamboree (July 28, 2023). **EXPANDED AGE CRITERIA FOR SCOUTS**
- If the participant is over 18, MUST be current with Youth Protection Training.
- Be approved by the unit leader and the Heart of Virginia Council.
- MUST have appropriate parent/guardian to complete the online parental consent.
- Participate in pre-Jamboree training experience with local council and unit leader.
- Submitted BSA Annual Health & Medical Record using the on-line Jamboree submission process. The AHMR must be dated on or after July 1, 2022.
- Submit all registrations fees per the HOVC's payment schedule.



NATIONAL SCOUT JAMBOREE – ATTENDING CONTINUED

YOUTH QUALIFICATIONS

Venturing, Explorers, & Sea Scouts

- Crew/Post/Ship members MUST have a current BSA membership with a Venturing crew, Explorer Post, or Ship.
- Has not reached their 21st birthday by the last day of the Jamboree (July 28, 2023).
- If the participant is over 18, MUST be current with Youth Protection Training.
- Be approved by the unit leader and the Heart of Virginia Council.
- MUST have appropriate parent/guardian to complete the online parental consent.
- Participate in pre-Jamboree training experience with local council and unit leader.
- Submitted BSA Annual Health & Medical Record using the on-line Jamboree submission process. The AHMR must be dated on or after July 1, 2022.
- Submit all registrations fees per the HOVC's payment schedule.



NATIONAL SCOUT JAMBOREE – ATTENDING CONTINUED

ADULT QUALIFICATIONS

- MUST have a current BSA membership in a local council unit.
- All leaders regardless of assigned position MUST be at least 21 years of age by the first day of the Jamboree (July 19, 2023).
- All Leaders MUST be approved by the Heart of Virginia Council.
- Scoutmaster and Assistant Scoutmasters MUST currently be serving in any unit leadership position.
- Scoutmaster applicants MUST have completed appropriate leader specific training.
- All adults MUST be current with Youth Protection Training.
- All adults must register online through the Jamboree registration system as a "Leader". The council will designate specific leadership positions at the time the Jamboree units are assigned.
- Participate and assist in planning the pre-Jamboree training experience with HOVC.
- The Unit Care Provider must be one of the Unit Leaders (SM or ASM) and is required to hold either current Wilderness First Aid and CPR certificates or a current healthcare license (MD, DO, APRN, RN, PA, Paramedic, EMT). This unit leader's responsibilities include providing for the safety and well-being of each unit member by a) reviewing their AHMR and maintaining a binder/file containing all of the Unit's AHMRs, b) maintaining the Unit First Aid Kit and providing first aid treatment within the unit and c) overseeing administration of required medications.
- Submitted BSA Annual Health & Medical Record using the on-line Jamboree submission process. The AHMR must be dated on or after July 1, 2022.
- Submit all registrations fees per the HOVC's payment schedule.

NATIONAL SCOUT JAMBOREE – HOW DO I REGISTER?



Apply to attend the Jamboree on the National Scout Jamboree website https://jamboree.scouting.org/

All interested youth and adult applicants can apply to attend the Jamboree. Youth apply as "participants" (troop/crew members). Adults apply as volunteer staff members. Applicants follow the instructions posted on the National website.

For youth Jamboree applicants, be sure to use the youth applicant's BSA Member ID, not a parent's or guardian's BSA Member ID number.

NATIONAL SCOUT JAMBOREE – ATTENDEE FEE

\$1,950* - WHAT'S INCLUDED?

- National Jamboree Fee \$1,250
- Transportation to & from Jamboree in a tour bus
- Jamboree patch
- Contingent SWAG
- Contingent shakedown weekend food & activities

Troops may also elect to create on their own SWAG for additional \$

Registrations after August 15, 2022 will have a \$50 late fee applied, and if your payment balance is not current on December 15, 2022, you may be subject to an additional \$50 late fee. These late fees will be added to your final payment.

Any payments made by credit/debit card will have a 3% surcharge added. Payments can be made by cash or check in person at the Council Leadership Center or check payments can be made by mail.


Personal Gear

- Jamboree will provide cot & troop cooking gear




