So... You're Thinking About Becoming A **TRAINED ADULT LEADER?**

We are glad to have you on board for this crazy, fun-filled adventure! Here's what you need to know.

A Word of WELCOME:

Scouting is a GREAT ADVENTURE! We hope you make this important commitment-but be prepared because it's a LOT of FUN! You will see, first-hand, your Cubs, Scouts and Venturers having a great time—and you'll be seeing and doing things that you might not otherwise be able to do. We're glad you're considering taking an ACTIVE role!

The BASICS:

All scout leaders MUST be REGISTERED and TRAINED to ensure a safe, fun learning environment for our youth. This includes Cubmasters, Scoutmasters, Committee Members, Den Leaders, Assistant Leaders, Crew Advisors, etc. Scouts BSA will conduct a required background check for each leader. Read about the <u>Adult Leader Selection Process</u>.

The UNIFORM:

Generally, each Unit (Pack, Troop, Crew or Ship) expects all Adult Leaders to wear their own official Uniform SHIRT to all meetings and scheduled events. Visit our <u>Scout Shop</u> at 8090 Villa Park Drive in Henrico to purchase yours!

(We are part of a TEAM...just like a soccer team or a basketball squad. So, we dress the part!)

The TRAINING:

Scouts BSA[®] provides iconic free or low-cost Boy Scouts of America[®] training. You will gain the tools and knowledge you need to be successful as a leader...AND it looks AWESOME on a resumé, too! **Nearly everything** you need can be found on-line* at the

BSA Learn Center - My.Scouting.org

Just set up your personal account (don't lose that password!) and complete the minimums:

- Youth Protection Training (YPT): All leaders MUST complete the latest version BEFORE direct contact with youth...and RETAKE it every 2 years.
- 2. Weather Hazards Training: This training covers all types of weather situations and should be renewed every 2 years.
- 3. **Position-Specific Training:** Download the <u>official training handout</u>.
- Camping: Leader training for campouts (BALOO and IOLS) is not offered on-line. You MUST campout during your training!
- 5. Leadership for Events with Girls: A registered and fully trained female leader at least 21 must be present at all Scouts BSA events with girls in attendance.
